Mark 1:1-20

Division 1: John the Baptist prepares the way.

Mark 1: 1-8

(Additional passages: Luke 3:15; Isaiah 40:10; Malachi 3:1; Matthew 1:21; Matthew 11:10; Isaiah 40:3; Isaiah 57:14-15; Isaiah 57:15; Matthew 5:4)

Principle #1: *We must mourn over our sin to see our need for grace.*

Division 2: The baptism and testing of Jesus.

Mark 1: 9-13

(Additional Passages: Matthew 3:14; Matthew 3:15; Genesis 1:2; Isaiah 53:11; Matthew 4:2; Matthew 4:3; Matthew 4:4; Matthew 4:6; Psalm 91:11; Matthew 4:7; Matthew 4:9; Matthew 4:10; Hebrews 4:15; Hebrews 4:16)

Principle #2: We are easily tempted to sin because sin is in us but Jesus overcame all temptation.

Division 3: Jesus announces the Good News and calls His first disciples.
