Mark 13:1 – 37

Introduction: When something begins, something else ends.

(Additional passages: Mark 1:1; Mark 14:22; Mark 1:14-15; John 12:29-33)

Division 1: There are Battles to Engage.

(Additional passages: Revelation 12:9-10; Exodus 19:5-6, 8; Mark 13:2; Ephesians 6:13-17; 1 Corinthians 10:13; Mark 13:10)

Division 2: Many Battles but One Victory.

Mark 13:22-23

(Additional Passages: 1 John 4:1-3; Matthew 7:16; 2 Timothy 4:3; 1 Corinthians 2:6-8; Daniel 11:31; Mark 13:19-20)

Division 3: Many Battles but One Victory.

Mark 13:29

(Additional Passages: Hosea 9:10; Mark 11; Mark 13:28; Acts 1:11; Mark 13:32-33)

Principle #2: The gospel must be proclaimed, so do not be distracted. I will return in unquestioned power and with a glorious victory establishing my kingdom on earth.

Principle #3: Christ's return is at hand and as the end draws near it is a time for wakeful activity carrying out our mission to being the gospel to the whole world.
