Lesson 8: "The Promise of Life"

Romans 4:13-25



Division 1: Paul summarizes the promises to Abraham as one promise in which he is to be heir of the world.

Romans 4:13

Additional Passages: Genesis 12:2-3; 12:7; Genesis 15; Genesis 17:7; Genesis 22:16-18; Exodus 3:6; Mathew 22:29; Galatians 3:16; Galatians 3:8; Psalm 2:8; Galatians 3:26-29; Ephesians 1:13-14; 1 John 3:2; 1 Corinthians 6:3; Psalm 37

Principle #1(a): God promises all people, who have the righteousness that comes by faith, will inherit the Earth.

Principle #1(b): Our inheritance is what Jesus inherits.

Division 2: Paul explains why God's promise to bless all nations, required salvation by faith rather than by law.

Romans 4:14-17

Principle #2: People, who emulate Abraham's faith in God's Word, are spiritual descendants of Abraham and declared righteous along with him.

Division 3: Paul explains that God's method of salvation is still the same as it was in Abraham's day.

Romans 4:18-23

Principle #3: God still credits righteousness to everyone who believes in God and is fully persuaded in the Truth of what God says in His Word.
