



Division 1: Justification has produced peace with God and hope for all Believers.

Romans 5:1-4

Additional Passages: John 3:36; 2 Corinthians 5:15-18; Exodus 32:18-23; Matthew 5:8; 2 Thessalonians 2:7; 1 John 3:2; Revelations 1:13, 19:7-8 & 14; Romans 8:17

Division 2: Justification causes the Holy Spirit to dwell in us – and to love God.

Romans 5:5-8

Additional Passages: Galatians 5:22; John 14:21; Ezekiel 36:27

Principle #1(a): *Justification by faith causes us to have peace with God and to be used by God as ambassadors of peace.*

Principle #1(b): *Justification by faith causes us to know we will see the Father's and the Son's glory and share in the Son's.*

Principle #1(c): *In order to share in Jesus' glory we must share in His suffering.*

Principle #2: *The Holy Spirit uses the Gospel to prove God's love for us and to move us to love and obey God.*

Division 3: Jesus uses his ongoing life to save us from God's ongoing wrath.

Romans 5:9-11

Additional Passages: John 3:36, Rom 8:34; 1 John 2:1; Luke 22:31

Principle #3: Because Jesus lives, we have an advocate in Heaven, who intercedes for us, saving us from God's ongoing wrath for our ongoing sin.
